

CURRICULUM VITAE

Viktor Gumi is the managing partner of law firm “GUMI & Associates” since January 2014. He has been Member of Albanian Parliament 2009-2013 and member and secretary of the Committee on Legal Issues, Human Rights and Public Administration. He has been member of the Parliamentary *ad hoc* committee on Electoral Reform in 2012 and previously has participated as technical expert in drafting the Electoral Code in 2008 and amending it in 2015.

Viktor Gumi was a member of the Venice Commission 2008 – 2016.

Viktor Gumi was graduated at the Law Faculty, University of Tirana in 1996. In year 2000, he attended the long-term course on the legal writing, organized by RIPA International – London, upon the successful accomplishment of which, he was awarded the “distinction” certificate. He pursued the master studies in 2001-2002 at the University of Essex, United Kingdom, focusing on International Human Rights Law and he was graduated with excellent results (*distinction*).

He was a participant of International Visitor Leadership Program in United States in 2008.

During the time period, 1999-2001, Viktor Gumi worked as the legal adviser in the Albanian Parliament, Secretary of the Standing Committee of the Albanian Parliament to the OSCE PA and also member of the Steering Committee of the Official Publications Center. During the period of time 2006-2007, he was also the member of CEPEJ (Council of Europe).

In the period, 2002-2006 he served as the Director of the Juridical Department and General Director of the Legislative Service in the Albanian Parliament.

During the time period, 2006-2008 he was appointed the Codification General Director at the Ministry of Justice.

Viktor Gumi has a very rich academic career. In the years 1999-2005, he was a lecturer of the subject “The Legislative Drafting”, at the Law Faculty, University of Tirana. Since 2005 and onward he is lecturing at the School of Magistrates.

Viktor Gumi is the author of a series of publications and lectures focusing on the justice field. He is also the author of the book “The legislative writing”, published in September 2006.

He has closely worked with international organizations in Tirana: OSCE/ODIHR, EU, UNWOMEN, UN, USAID, UNDP, CoE, etc.
